

Soft Reset

Allows many changes to be made that used to require a server side reset. A soft reset clears all caches in the Viewer making recent changes appear without the need to restart LUNA tomcat on the server.

Changes in the Administrator:

- Changing the Collection order
- IP range
- Application Configuration
- Changing ownership in Media groups and presentations
- Collection Properties
- Category Properties
- Extended Collection Properties

Changes in Collection Manager:

- OAI mappings
- Relay button properties
